<i>i</i>	<i>Decisions by a Party on regulating the transit of specific living modified organisms (LMOs)</i> CPB. Art. 6 para. 1
<i>j</i>	<i>Notifications on an occurrence resulting in a release that leads, or may lead to unintentional transboundary movement of an LMO that is likely to have significant adverse effects on biological diversity and related information, including contact point for further information</i> CPB. Art. 17 para. 1-& 3
<i>k</i>	<i>Notifications concerning cases of Illegal transboundary movements of LMOs</i> CPB. Art. 25 para. 3
<i>l</i>	<i>Final decisions regarding the importation or release of LMOs (i.e., approval or prohibition, any conditions, requests for further information, extensions granted, reasons for decision)</i> CPB. Art. 10 para. 3; & Art. 20 para. 3(d)
<i>m</i>	<i>Final decisions regarding the domestic use of LMOs that may be subject to transboundary movement for direct use as food or feed or for processing</i> CPB. Art. 11 paragraph 1
<i>n</i>	<i>Final decisions regarding the import of LMOs intended for direct use as food or feed or for processing that are taken under domestic regulatory frameworks</i> (CPB. Art. 11 para. 4) or in accordance with annex III (CPB. Art. 11 para. 6) and requirement of CPB. Art. 20 para. 3(d)
<i>o</i>	<i>Declarations regarding the framework to be used for LMOs intended for direct use as food or feed or for processing (LMO-FFPs)</i> CPB. Article 11 paragraph 6
<i>p</i>	<i>Notifications on review and change of decisions regarding intentional transboundary movements of LMOs</i> CPB. Art. 12 para. 1
<i>q</i>	<i>LMOs subject to simplified procedures regarding intentional transboundary movement and exempted by a Party from the AIA procedure</i> CPB. Art. 13, para 1
<i>r</i>	<i>Decisions by a Party on contained use of specific living modified organisms (LMOs)</i> CPB. Art. 6 para. 2

s	<i>Decisions on field trial, confined field trial, or experimental intentional introduction when the conditions specified in CPB. Art. 3, para b, are unmet</i> CP-9/12
t	<i>Decisions regarding the first import of LMOs for intentional introduction into the environment</i> CPB. Articles 7-10
u	<i>Information on the application of domestic regulations to specific imports of LMOs</i> CPB. Art. 14 para. 4

v	<i>Reports submitted by the Parties on the implementation of the Protocol</i> CPB. Art. 20 para. 3 (e) & Art. 33
w	<i>Summaries of risk assessments or environmental reviews of LMOs generated by regulatory processes and relevant information regarding products thereof, namely processed materials that are of living modified organism origin, containing detectable novel combinations of replicable genetic material obtained through the use of modern biotechnology</i> CPB. Art. 20 para. 3 (c)
x	<i>Communication of information on 'Handling, Transport, Packaging and Identification'</i> CPB. Art. 18; decision BS-III/10
	<i>COP-MOP urges to provide information pertaining:</i>
y	<i>Decisions on the release or import of LMOs taken prior to entry into force of the Protocol (BS-I/3 paragraph 5, BS-II/2 paragraph 4, BS-III/2 paragraph 3, BS-IV/2 paragraph 2)</i>
z	<i>Risk assessments taken prior to entry into force of the Protocol (BS-II/2 paragraph 4, BS-III/2 paragraph 3, BS-IV/2 paragraph 2)</i>
aa	<i>Risk assessment summaries for all instances when requested by the Protocol including, inter alia, intentional introductions of LMOs into the environment for field trials regardless on whether or not the living organism will be subjected to future transboundary movement or commercialization (BS-V/2 paragraph 1a)</i>
