Designate one national focal point responsible for liaison with the Secretariat and provide name/address to the Secretariat	Article 19-1; Article 19-2
Designate one or more competent authorities responsible for performing the administrative functions required by the Protocol and provide name(s)/address(es) to the Secretariat. If more than one authority, indicate the types of LMOs for which each competent authority is responsible	Article 19-1; Article 19-2
Designate one BCH focal point responsible for validating information on the BCH and provide name/email address to the Secretariat in order to activate BCH account.	COP-MOP decision BS- I/3 (BCH Modalities of Operation)
Designate a point of contact for receiving information from other States on unintentional transboundary movements in accordance with Article 17 and submit it to the BCH.	Article 17-2
Submit to the BCH any relevant existing laws, regulations or guidelines, information necessary for the AIA procedure and laws applicable to the import of LMO-FFPs	Article 20-3(a); Article 11-5

Submit to the BCH final decisions regarding the import of LMOs intended for direct use as food or feed, or for processing that are taken under domestic regulatory frameworks or in accordance with annex III (Article 11 paragraph 6) (requirement of Article 20 paragraph 3(d));	Article 11-4; Article 13-1
Submit to the BCH Declarations regarding the framework to be used for LMOs intended for direct use as food or feed, or for processing (Article 11 paragraph 6);	Article 11-6
If necessary, appoint National Authorized Users to assist with uploading information to the BCH. (National Focal Point must continue to validate information before publication)	n/a
Submit to the BCH final decisions concerning the import or release of LMOs:	Article 20-3(d)
 within 15 days of taking a decision under Article 11- 1 (LMO-FFPs); 	
 within 270 days of receiving the notification for the AIA procedure.

Notify the BCH about any changes in the designation of its national focal point or in the name and address or responsibilities of its competent national authority(s).	Article 19-2
Inform within 30 days the BCH about reviewing the previous decision regarding an intentional transboundary movement of an LMO	Article 12-1
Submit to the BCH Cases where intentional transboundary movement may take place at the same time as the movement is notified to the Party of import	Article 13-1
