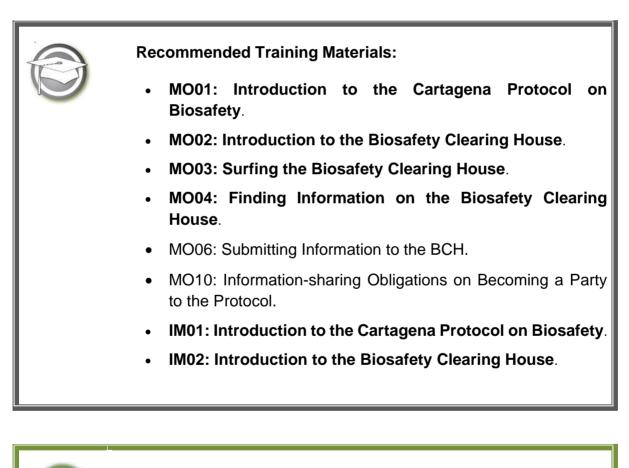
3. NGOs AND CIVIL SOCIETY
